Terms & Conditions



- Paradise Lagoons Campdraft is an Australian Campdraft Association and National Cutting Horse Association affiliated Campdraft and therefore all rules and conditions of the ACA and NCHA are applicable.
- 2. The Paradise Lagoons Campdraft Committee is GST registered. All nominations include GST, a tax invoice is issued online at time of nomination. For all prizemoney an ABN or hobby declaration is required and anyone wishing to collect GST on prizemoney will need to present a tax invoice with ABN to the Secretary. Failure to produce Tax Invoice will result in Prizemoney exclusive of GST. Prizemoney is GST exclusive. All Prizemoney will be deposited directly into competitor's nominated bank account unless otherwise advised. Please provide details when nominating.
- 3. Please note that all Prizemoney, Refunds and Scratchings will not be processed until after the conclusion of the event.
- NOMINATIONS OPEN Friday 26th April at 7.00am.
 NOMINATIONS CLOSE Tuesday 30th April at 7.00pm. NOMINATION FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES. Nominations will only be accepted upon FULL payment of fees.
- 5. Unless otherwise accepted, competitors can regard their entries as having been accepted but the Paradise Lagoons Campdraft Committee will in no way be responsible for non-receipt of such advice.
- 6. Owners of horses must state when nominating the order in which they wish their horses to compete. All horses starting from Number 1 must follow correct order Failure to observe this condition, at the discretion of the committee, may result in the nomination being disqualified.
- 7. All changes (ie run order, rider substitution and horse substitution) must be in hands of Secretary AT LEAST ONE HOUR before the start of the draft (earlier if possible). NB Only changes received by hard copy will be accepted over the course of the weekend. Forms will be available at the Secretaries office (Main office under Sponsors Pavilion Arena 1) No changes made by text will be accepted. Any changes made after the event starts will require a donation fee to the RFDS.
- 8. Draws will be sent via email and in some instances text message. We may use Text messages as a form to notify competitors of changes to events and announcements will also be made during the course of the events. We accept no responsibility for unread text messages or if incorrect phone numbers have been given.
- 9. Ladies Draft and Juvenile draft are limited to two entries per competitor. The Juvenile Draft is for ages 13 years under 17 years. All Campdrafts are open to any rider 13 years and over at the date of competition. Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA-affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- 10. The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse with exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of

horse participating eg. If one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open Draft.

- 11. A substitute horse will be allowed when the nominated horse cannot start. Name of substitute to be in hands of Secretary one hour before the start of the draft (earlier if possible). Horse must be bonafide property of the nominee. Veterinary certificate must be produced one hour before draft is run.
- 12. After closing date, Refunds of scratchings will be subject to the following ACA rulings. A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted, minus a \$30 stock levy. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee. Any scratchings will not be refunded unless a vet certificate is presented, or the committee receives photo or video proof that the horse cannot compete.
- 13. The decision of the Paradise Lagoons Campdraft Committee or all matters appertaining or incidental to the competition shall be final and conclusive and binding on all nominations for the competitions, and in addition, the committee reserves unto itself the right, at any time, without being liable for any loss or damage which may be sustained, to alter or postpone the date of the competition or cancel the same or to change the venue of the competitions.
- 14. Stallions There are no horse stalls available. All Stallions must comply with rule 11.12 of the ACA Rule Book.
- 15. No dogs allowed. (Assistance dogs are the only exception).
